CAMARAC - Mark Kantalinsky-Vasilyev + Clàudia Jansana-Rodon

CAMARAC is a non-profit international collective of young artists and architects. The collective identifies and works on social injustices within the framework of big urban systems.

They consider art to be an essential tool for protest and work to make cities evolve for the benefit of the community, and not at the community's expense. Their work is based on the pursuit of sustainable progress, based on citizen participation, and attentive and respectful of people's needs.

Mark is a Ukrainian refugee, architect, urbanist and art activist and Clàudia a filmmaker and multidisciplinary artist.

DOCAR - Rocio Calzado + Jasper Meurer

Docar is a documentary film collective founded in 2023 that explores urban controversies through political and architectural perspectives.

It was created by Jasper Meurer, a political scientist focused on migration, and Rocio Calzado, an architect specializing in housing and ecological transition.

After meeting at Sciences Po, they combined their backgrounds to examine the links between urbanism, architecture, and politics. Since 2024, Docar has also been a local partner of HouseEurope!
